1. ABOUT US

Corney and Barrow ("we", "our" and "us") is a company registered in Hong Kong SAR, China at 6D, 9 Queen's Road Central, Central, Hong Kong and is a specialist supplier of wine to consumers and the trade.

2. WHAT ARE COOKIES?

Cookies are small files of letters and numbers that are placed on your computer by websites that you visit. They are widely used in order to make websites work or work more efficiently, as well as to provide information to the owners of the site, for example, remembering your preferences, recording what you have put in your shopping basket and counting the number of people looking at a website. We use cookies and similar technologies to provide you with a functional website and to give you a more personalised service.

3. WHAT ARE COOKIES USED FOR?

We may use the following types of cookie:

- 3.1. Strictly Necessary Cookies - These are cookies that are required for the operation of a website. They include, for example, cookies that enable users to log into secure areas of a website, use a shopping cart or make use of e-billing services;
- 3.2. Analytical / Performance Cookies - They allow us to recognise and count the number of visitors and to see how they move around a website when it is being used. This helps us to improve the way a website works, for example, by ensuring that users are finding what they are looking for easily;
- 3.3. Functionality Cookies - These are used to recognise you when you return to a website. This enables us to personalise our content for you, greet you by name and remember your preferences (for example, your choice of language or region); and
- 3.4. Targeting Cookies - These cookies record your visit to a website, the pages you have visited and the links you have followed. This information may be used to make a website and the advertising displayed on it more relevant to your interests.

4. THIRD PARTY COOKIES

Some of the cookies we use are third party cookies. We work with other companies, such as search engine providers, so that we can learn more about our customers and

provide a more personalised service. You can learn more about how these third parties process information, by reading their privacy notices. 5. WHAT COOKIES DO WE USE?

- 5.1. The Corney and Barrow website, like many websites, makes use of cookies that track usage of our website (if your browser settings allow it). These cookies are completely anonymous meaning they will not personally identify you. We use Google Analytics software to measure how visitors engage with our website with the aim of improving our website for future visitors. An overview of these cookies can be found below.

- 5.3. Our Site uses analytics services provided by Google Analytics. Website analytics refers to a set of tools used to collect and analyse anonymous usage information, enabling Us to better understand how Our Site is used. This, in turn, enables Us to improve Our Site and the products and services offered through it. You do not have to allow Us to use these Cookies, however whilst Our use of them does not pose any risk to your privacy or your safe use of Our Site, it does enable Us to continually improve Our Site, making it a better and more useful experience for you.

5.4. View Google's Analytics Cookies:

COOKIE NAME	DESCRIPTION
__utma	Distinguishes shoppers and sessions .This cookie is created when the JavaScript library executes and there is no existing __utma cookie. The cookie is updated every time data is sent to Google Analytics.
__utmt	Used to throttle request rate.
__utmb	Determines new sessions/visits. This cookie is created when the JavaScript library executes and there is no existing __utmb cookie. The cookie is updated every time data is sent to Google Analytics.
__utmz	Saves the traffic source or campaign that explains how the shopper reached your site. The cookie is created when the JavaScript library executes, and is updated every time data is sent to Google Analytics

__utmv	Stores visitor-level custom variable data. This cookie is created when a developer uses the <code>_setCustomVar</code> method with a visitor-level custom variable. This cookie is updated every time data is sent to Google Analytics

5.5. View Magento's Analytics Cookies:

COOKIE NAME	DESCRIPTION
CART	The association with the customer's shopping cart.
CATEGORY_INFO	Stores the category info on the page to load pages faster.
COMPARE	The items in the customer's Compare Products list.
CUSTOMER	An encrypted version of the shopper's customer ID.
CUSTOMER_AUTH	Indicates if the customer is currently logged in to the store.
CUSTOMER_INFO	An encrypted version of the shopper's customer group.
EXTERNAL_NO_CACHE	Indicates if caching is disabled or enabled.
FRONTEND	The customer's session ID.
GUEST-VIEW	Determines if guests can edit their orders.
LAST_CATEGORY	The last category visited by the shopper.
LAST_PRODUCT	The most recent product viewed by the shopper.
NEWMESSAGE	Indicates whether a new message has been received.
NO_CACHE	Indicates if the cache can be used to store information.

PERSISTENT_SHOPPING_CART	A link to information about the shopper's cart and viewing history.
RECENTLYCOMPARED	Items recently compared by the shopper.
STF	Information on products the shopper has emailed to friends.
STORE	The store view or language chosen by the shopper.
USER_ALLOWED_SAVE_COOKIE	Indicates if the shopper allows cookies to be saved.
VIEWED_PRODUCT_IDS	The products recently viewed by the shopper.
WISHLIST	An encrypted list of products added to the shopper's wishlist.
WISHLIST_CNT	The number of items in the shopper's wishlist.
